KW Skating Club

The KWSC is located in the twin cities of Kitchener-Waterloo; our home facility is the *Carolyn Fedy Skating Centre*, in Waterloo at the RIM Park complex, which includes four Olympic size rinks, a mirrored, hardwood studio space, an athletic centre, food concessions, and a skate shop. Celebrating our 75th anniversary in 2013-14, KWSC organizes programs from pre-school to adults, with over 2000 recreational skating members. We operate competitive programs that have sent Singles Skaters, Dance Pairs, Freeskate Pairs, and Synchronized Teams to compete in the Canadian Championships, as well as International Competitions. The KWSC is one of Canada's largest figure skating clubs.

The Canskate Coach will report directly to the Technical Director and will be assigned to sessions scheduled within each season.

Job Summary

- The Coach will be responsible for executing the provided curriculum, as outlined by Skate Canada, in a group lesson format.
- Will provide a fun, safe and educational environment for skaters.
- Coach must assess skater's ability against the standard and prepare written report card at the conclusion of each season. Report card information may be entered into KWSC badge tracking system, if required.
- Provide two volunteer service hours throughout the year to support special events or promotional activities within the KWSC.
- Will assist the team where possible by accepting substitute teaching assignments.

Qualifications

The successful candidate would possess the following:

- A current Skate Canada coaching member.
- Primary STARSkate certification or currently working on completing.
- Completed New CanSkate on line module.
- Attended a Region or Section New CanSkate Clinic.
- Ideally has worked with a club that is participating in the New CanSkate program.
- Access to transportation to be able to work at rinks all around Kitchener Waterloo.
- Must be available for a minimum of 3 hours per week for Fall and winter seasons and have the flexibility to accept substitute assignments for other sessions.
