Are you a Voter or an Observer?

The Skate Canada By-Laws and KWSC's constitution define each member's status as voter or observer as follows:

You are a Voter if:

- You are of legal age, have paid your Skate Canada membership fees and skating in a KWSC skating program*. **(Active Member)**
- You are the parent of an underage child skating in a KWSC skating program and have paid your child's Skate Canada membership fees (usually charged once per year with your program registration fees). Note: limit one vote per family in this category, regardless of the number of children skating in KWSC skating programs. **(Special Member)**
- Board of Directors (including the Coaching Rep), Chairs of committees appointed by the Board of Directors & members of the Advisory. This includes Gala Chair, Showcase Chair, Test Chair, and Alumni Chair. **(Individual Member)**

***NOTE: you do not need to be registered as a skater with KWSC – as long as your skater's Skate Canada membership fees are paid (charged once a year with your program costs) and you are registered and skating in a KWSC Skating program, you are eligible to vote.**

You are an Observer if:

- A long-time figure head for KWSC and confirmed as an honorary member at a General Meeting. **(Honorary Member)**
- You are registered as a KWSC member but not skating in a KWSC Skating program. Officials & 'friends of KWSC' fall into this category. **(Community Member)**
- You are a paid professional dance partner or performer, a paid coach or staff member or a member of the KWSC Club Coaching Committee. **(Restricted Member)**
