Dear Skater and Families:

The KWSC Board of Directors is proud to be able to support skaters of the Kitchener Waterloo Skating Club for ongoing training at KWSC facilities through our Skater Development Fund in the form of ice credits. Please refer to the guidelines set out in this letter to ensure your skaters eligibility.

The credits distributed for the 2011-2012 skating season are for skaters entering the 2010-11 BMO Championship stream of competitions (including Junior National's) in all single, dance pairs, and pair skating disciplines.

Skaters who have declared the Kitchener Waterloo Skating Club as their home club are entitled to the full funds as allowable by the guidelines. Non-club skaters training with the KWSC also have access to the funds based on the qualifications outlined by the Skater Development Fund guidelines.

QUALIFICATIONS BASED ON FALL/WINTER 2010-2011 REGISTRATION:

Juvenile category skaters are required to register for a minimum of 7 hours of ice in the primary programs per week with the KWSC for the Fall and Winter sessions to be eligible for funding.

Pre-novice category of skaters are required to register for a minimum of 8 hours of ice in the primary programs per week with the KWSC for the Fall and Winter sessions to be eligible for funding.

Novice and higher categories of skaters are required to register for a minimum of 9 hours of ice in the primary program per week with the KWSC for the Fall and Winter sessions to be eligible for funding.

If skaters are enrolled in more than one discipline, the required program hours must total 150% of the greater of the single discipline, dance pairs or pair program (e.g. enrolment as a Novice single and Junior Pair would require total of 13.5 hours per week)

Please understand that funding may be withdrawn should an athlete be found in violation of the Code of Conduct set out by the club, Western Ontario Section, or Skate Canada.
