RECREATIONAL SKATING PROGRAMS
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We will again be offering all our programs in two 9 weeks sessions. The Fall session will begin October 16/10 and the Winter session will begin January 3/11. You can register for either or both sessions starting in September. Skaters must have reached the required age for the program by October 1, 2010 for Fall programs and January 1, 2011 for Winter programs.

PARENT & TOT PROGRAM - AGES 2-3

This is an introductory program for 2 & 3 year olds who are accompanied by an adult 18 years or older, who must have competent skating abilities and be able to assist the tot throughout the lesson. No skating aids or hockey sticks permitted. Games, songs & toys are used in this program.

PRESCHOOL (CANSKATE) - AGES 3-5

This program is a fun way to introduce your young child to skating. Skaters are placed in groups according to their ability and are taught in a group setting. Games and toys are used to assist in teaching. Parents are not permitted on the ice.

CANSKATE - AGES 5-12

The CanSkate program teaches a variety of skating skills and is beneficial to any child with an interest in ice sports. Skaters earn badges and are grouped according to badge level and taught in a group setting.

PRE-POWER - AGES 4 & 5

This program is designed for young skaters who can stand up on skates and move forwards on their own. Skaters develop basic skating skills in a power skating specific environment. Helmet, neck guard, gloves & stick are required.

RECREATIONAL STAR

This program is for skaters who have passed their CanSkate Stage 6 badge or have been recommend by their coach and want to continue developing their skating skills at a recreational level. Freeskate, dance, skills & synchronized skating are taught in a group setting.

LEARN TO SKATE COMMUNITY PROGRAMS - AGES 5-15

This program is offered and taught by the KWSC and the ice is provided by the City of Waterloo & the City of Kitchener. This program teaches basic skating skills (forwards, backwards, stopping). Skaters are placed in large groups according to their ability. This is an excellent program to enroll your child in to aid in their school skating curriculum or to learn to skate with their peers.

ADULT PROGRAMS - AGES 15 +

Adult skating programs are for beginners and experienced skaters. We also offer an Adult Social Dance Program (a fun night of ice dancing for adults with knowledge of the Skate Canada dances).
