Enclosed you will find your registration package for Fall/Winter 2010-2011. Please take time to review all of the enclosed information carefully. **The application deadline is August 5/10 at 7 pm.** Remember, forms received prior to the registration start date & time (July 15/10 at 12 pm) will not be accepted.

E-MAIL ADDRESS: Please ensure you provide a current e-mail address as the majority of club correspondence will be done via e-mail.

All sections of the registration form must be completed in full or the application will be returned unprocessed - this includes the tests passed section. Refer to our financial and prioritizing policies outlined on the back page of the Fall/Winter 2010-2011 brochure.

The club will be continuing this year with the WOS raffle ticket fundraiser. You will again have the option of paying a set fee (\$120.00) and receive no books or paying a set fee (\$200.00) and receive 5 books of tickets of which you can sell and make your money back.

Effective July 1st the provincial government has enacted a 13% HST in place of the 5% GST. This tax is placed on services we buy to provide programs to our members, most significantly on ice costs, and we have no choice but to pass it on to our members in the form of increased fees. The KWSC Board has taken funds from our reserves to counter the effects of this new tax for this season so you will notice that program costs have not been raised as a result. We will be sending more information about this with your confirmation, asking you to participate in a campaign to demand the government make an exception for minor sports organizations with regard to HST on services. We hope for your support.
