Groups will be based on age and gender where entries allow.

WO Recreational: CanSkate, Introductory W.O. event, Pre-Preliminary A, Preliminary A & B, & Junior Bronze, Senior Bronze Limited, Pre-Juvenile

STARSkate: Pre-Preliminary to Gold

Interpretive: STARSkate (Pre-Introductory to Gold) - Groups will be organized according to registrations

KWSC - SPECIAL EVENTS

Rec Star continuous elements

The skater has one minute to complete continuous elements (to be determined), on half of the ice surface. Skaters must be enrolled in the KWSC recreational Star program.

Rec Star elements in isolation

The skater has elements (to be determined) to complete, each in isolation, on half of the ice surface. Skaters must be enrolled in the KWSC recreational Star program.

The “Old-fashioned-definition-of-Interpretive” Event

Invent your own choreography! You will hear the music three times during your warm-up and then all skaters go to a soundproof room. Each skater performs their own routine, one skater at a time.

Theme: "Christmas"

Program: 1.5 min

Jumps shall not be more than one rotation. Skaters will be grouped by level, as numbers permit.
