What to bring: Your letter of recommendation.

What is the Enrichment Program?

- ~ Enrichment is the fast tracking of a CanSkate skater who shows an interest in the sport of figure skating.
- ~ Skaters will advance quickly into the Skate Canada Test stream.
- ~ This is a 2 day/week program, which includes both on & off ice components.
 - ~ An optional 3rd day of skating in the CanSkate program is available.

Goals/Objectives

- ~ Provide the opportunity for your skater to accelerate their progress through an important building block of elements.
- ~ The emphasis is placed on skating technique with power, speed, agility, 4 basic edges, beginning skills in jumps, spins, and field movements.
- ~ Off ice classes will focus on your child's physical attributes to enhance their skating development.

Who is Eligible?

- ~ Current Enrichment skaters that meet program standards and development.
- ~ Any skater who has received a letter of recommendation or has received approval from the program coordinator.

Parent's Commitment

- ~ Parent/legal guardian must be willing to bring their child to the arena a minimum of 2 times per week.
- ~ Provide proper figure skating apparel & equipment for your child.
 - ~ Provide proper fitness clothing and footwear.

What is the Skate Canada Test Stream?

- ~ Skaters usually enter the test stream after the completion of the Enrichment program.
- ~ There are three main disciplines in figure skating: skills, freeskate, and dance. The test structure begins at the Preliminary test level and progresses up to the Gold test level.
 - ~ At KWSC, the entry level of the test stream is the Junior STAR program. At this point, instruction is taught through private lessons (fees extra) by a Skate Canada coach.



ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

Skaters may select a 3rd day of skating in the CanSkate Program.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- ~ Figure skates are required for this program.
- ~ Please make sure your child's skates are sharpened before the first day of skating.
 Regular sharpening is recommended.
- ~ Please be on time for your session.
- ~ Regular attendance is required for both days, including the off ice class.
- ~ Proper skating attire is required for the ice (no jeans). Girls may wear skating skirts and/or dresses and long hair must be pulled back. Boys can wear track pants.
- ~ Layered clothing is important for warmth and mittens/gloves are essential.
- ~ Remember to put a cloth in your bag to dry off your skates.
 Do not leave your guards on your skates.
- ~ Skaters are required to have running shoes for the off ice class.
- ~ A small snack is recommended for the Sunday program.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

ALL FEES ARE IN CANADIAN FUNDS. PLEASE MAKE CHEQUES PAYABLE TO THE KITCHENER WATERLOO SKATING CLUB (KWSC). CHEQUES MUST INCLUDE YOUR TELEPHONE NUMBER AND BE SUBMITTED WITH THE REGISTRATION FORM.

Registrants for all programs must pay in full with the submission of the registration form or adhere to the payment schedule designed for their particular program. Financial arrangements other than the above must be authorized and arranged with Tara Dilgert, Membership Services, prior to April 1, 2010

The annual (September 1, 2009 to August 31, 2010) Skate Canada (\$31.00) fee is due once per skating year. New KWSC Home Club members must submit this fee with this registration form. Because the KWSC is a member of Skate Canada, it is mandatory that all participants in a Skate Canada sanctioned program become a member in order to provide liability coverage and to maintain our operating sanction. (Skaters who are registered with other clubs must provide their Skate Canada Membership Card upon registration).

REFUND POLICY: There are **NO REFUNDS** or return of post-dated cheques. All returned cheques will be charged a \$25.00 administration fee (fee subject to change without notice). Fees must be paid before the start of the program. Skaters with outstanding accounts will not be allowed on the ice.

After name tag has been issued: **a)** withdrawal from the program does not remove the obligation to honour post-dated cheques and **b)** program changes are to be requested in writing and are subject to a \$15.00 processing fee. Refunds for medical reasons will be issued, upon receipt of a Medical Doctor's note, on a pro-rated basis (using the date on the medical note or the accident report form) **except** for the base fee and Skate Canada fee, which are non-refundable.

Be aware that there is **NO Make-Up Policy** for programs cancelled due to inclement weather, city ice deletions where relocating the program is not possible or any other unforeseen circumstances in which the KWSC cannot be held responsible.

The KWSC has the right to remove a skater and/or parent/legal guardian from the session for inappropriate, abusive and/or dangerous behaviour on the ice.

KWSC reserves the right to correct any errors or omissions in this brochure. KWSC has the right to change or cancel any program that has an insufficient paid registration. In the event of a substantial change to a program or cancellation, registrants will be offered a full or pro-rated refund, as appropriate.
