ADULT CANSKATE PROGRAM: Ages 15 +

A skating program for adults of all ages and levels. Skaters are taught according to ability and have lots of fun!

PARENT & TOT PROGRAM – Ages 2 & 3 *Note: There is no refund policy for this program*

This is an introductory skating program for children that are 2 and 3 years of age who are accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older. In order to register for this program, tots must be 2 years of age as of April 1, 2010. The accompanying adult must have competent skating abilities and must be able to assist the tot throughout the lesson. A Skate Canada coach will lead each 45 minute session using games, songs and toys. There are no skating aids or hockey sticks allowed on the ice. **All tots are required to wear a properly fitted CSA approved helmet. The accompanying adult is required to pay the \$31.00 Skate Canada Membership Fee for insurance purposes, therefore the same adult must accompany the tot each week.**

PRESCHOOL (CANSKATE) PROGRAM: Ages 3 – 5

The focus of this program is to make skating fun! Skating skills taught range from learning to stand and balance to going forwards and backwards. This program is the entry level for beginners who are 3 - 5 years of age. Children are placed into groups according to ability and taught by a Professional Coach and assisted by qualified CanSkate Program Assistants. Children must be 3 - 5 years of age as of April 1, 2010. Properly fitted CSA approved helmets are **required** for all skaters. Parents are **NOT** allowed on the ice. Expect a 2 or 3 week adjustment period for some of the younger and/or newer participants.

Preschool Refund Policy: Due to the young age of these skaters, our refund policy allows for a \$ 60 refund to those who withdraw **PRIOR** to the **FOURTH** skating lesson.

CANSKATE PROGRAM: Ages 5-12

The focus of this program is to learn and develop a variety of skating skills. This program is beneficial to any skater with an interest in ice sports (figure skating, hockey, ringette). Participants earn badges while they learn fundamental skating skills. Skaters are placed in groups according to ability and taught by a Professional Coach and assisted by qualified CanSkate Program Assistants. Children **must** be 5 years of age as of April 1, 2010. Properly fitted CSA approved helmets are strongly recommended for beginners.

RECREATIONAL STARSKATE

Recreational STARSkate offers opportunities for skaters of all ages who wish to continue to develop fundamental figure skating skills in the areas of ice dance, skating skills, free skate and interpretive skating. This program teaches figure skating skills in a group lesson format in a progressive and sequential manner. Skaters have the opportunity to take Skate Canada standardized tests at the Preliminary Free Skate, Skating Skills and Junior Bronze Dance levels Tests, although the focus of this program is not the achievement of these tests. To register in this program, skaters must have passed their Stage 6 CanSkate badge or have been recommended to this program by a professional coach. Independent learning is encouraged. Private lessons may be available – please contact the KWSC office if interested.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- ~ Spaces are limited. Programs are filled on a first-come first-serve basis.
- ~ Registration **MUST be completed in person**. Program tags will not be mailed.
- ~ Cash, debit or personal cheques are accepted for payment. (Sorry, we do not accept credit cards)
- ~ Proof of age is required for all **NEW** members. Please bring a Birth Certificate, Passport or Health Card.
- ~ Programs are subject to schedule changes.
- ~ Fees must be paid before the start of the program. Cheques are made payable to KWSC and must include a phone number. See the “Financial Information” section below for further information.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

ALL FEES ARE IN CANADIAN FUNDS. PLEASE MAKE CHEQUES PAYABLE TO THE KITCHENER WATERLOO SKATING CLUB (KWSC). CHEQUES MUST INCLUDE YOUR TELEPHONE NUMBER AND BE SUBMITTED WITH THE REGISTRATION FORM.

Registrants for all programs must pay in full with the submission of the registration form or adhere to the payment schedule designed for their particular program. Financial arrangements other than the above must be authorized and arranged with Tara Dilgert, Membership Services, prior to April 1, 2010

The annual (September 1, 2009 to August 31, 2010) Skate Canada (\$31.00) fee is due once per skating year. New KWSC Home Club members must submit this fee with this registration form. Because the KWSC is a member of Skate Canada, it is mandatory that all participants in a Skate Canada sanctioned program become a member in order to provide liability coverage and to maintain our operating sanction. (Skaters who are registered with other clubs must provide their Skate Canada Membership Card upon registration).

REFUND POLICY: There are **NO REFUNDS** (except Preschool – see Preschool Tryout Policy below) or return of post-dated cheques. All returned cheques will be charged a \$25.00 administration fee (fee subject to change without notice). Fees must be paid before the start of the program. Skaters with outstanding accounts will not be allowed on the ice.

After name tag has been issued: a) withdrawal from the program does not remove the obligation to honour post-dated cheques and b) program changes are to be requested in writing and are subject to a \$15.00 processing fee. Refunds for medical reasons will be issued, upon receipt of a Medical Doctor’s note, on a pro-rated basis (using the date on the medical note or the accident report form) **except** for the base fee and Skate Canada fee, which are non-refundable.

PRESCHOOL TRYOUT POLICY: Skaters who withdraw **PRIOR** to the **commencement** of the **fourth** class will be refunded \$ 60.00. **Refunds will NOT BE ISSUED after the commencement of the fourth class.**

Be aware that there is **NO Make-Up Policy** for programs cancelled due to inclement weather, city ice deletions where relocating the program is not possible or any other unforeseen circumstances in which the KWSC cannot be held responsible.

The KWSC has the right to remove a skater and/or parent/legal guardian from the session for inappropriate, abusive and/or dangerous behaviour on the ice.

KWSC reserves the right to correct any errors or omissions in this brochure. KWSC has the right to change or cancel any program that has an insufficient paid registration. In the event of a substantial change to a program or cancellation, registrants will be offered a full or pro-rated refund, as appropriate.
