The Kitchener-Waterloo Skating Club Board of Directors is hosting a trip to a live broadcast of CBC's *Battle of the Blades* at Pinewood Studios in Toronto. KWSC skaters are invited to enter a draw to be part of a live studio audience for a Monday night results show.

Return transportation to Pinewood Studios will be provided via chartered coach. The bus departs from RIM Park on Monday Nov. 1 at 4:00 pm. A group of KWSC staff, coaches and volunteers will serve as chaperones for the event.

All KWSC skaters aged 8 and up can enter by submitting the attached form. Skaters will be chosen by a random draw, and notified on Oct. 25. Skaters must be at least 8 years old and able to travel without a parent along with a group of approximately 50 skaters/chaperones.

WHEN AND WHERE: Admission and round-trip transportation via chartered coach will be provided to Pinewood Studios in Toronto on Monday November 1. The bus will depart RIM Park at 4:00 pm and return at approximately 9:15 pm.
